Introduction

- Araria district is one of the thirty-eight districts of Bihar state.
- Araria district is a part of Purnea division.
- It has a view of Mount Kanchenjunga(One of the great peaks of the Himalyan range)
- This district has total 2 sub- divisions namely Araria and Forbesganj and 9 blocks. Araria subdivision comprises six blocks: Araria, Jokihat, Kursakanta, Raniganj, Sikti and Palasi and Forbesganj sub-division comprises three blocks: Forbesganj, Narpatganj and Bhargama.
- There are six Vidhan Sabha constituencies in this district: Narpatganj, Raniganj(SC), Forbesganj, Araria, Jokihat and Sikti. All of these are part of Araria Lok Sabha constituency.
- Economy of araria district mainly depends on agriculture.

Araria has a very prestigious past though shrouded in midst of uncertainties. Some passages in the Mahabharata (Sabha Parva and Vana Parva) describing the conquest of Bhima in the eastern India furnish valuable information regarding the antiquity of the district. in the year 1864 Araria was constituted as Sub-Division by merging the small divisions of Araria, Matiari, Dimia, parts of Haveli and Bahadurganj to provide better administration and ultimately it became a district in 1990.





Raniganj Vriksh Vatika
